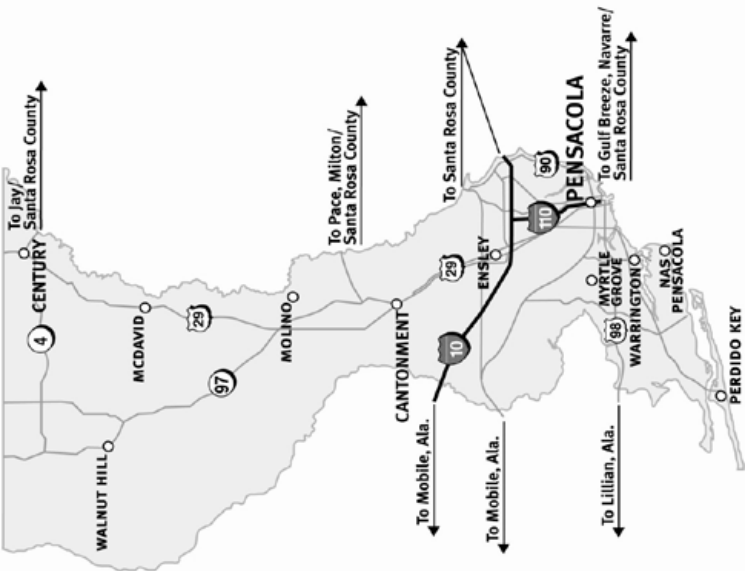
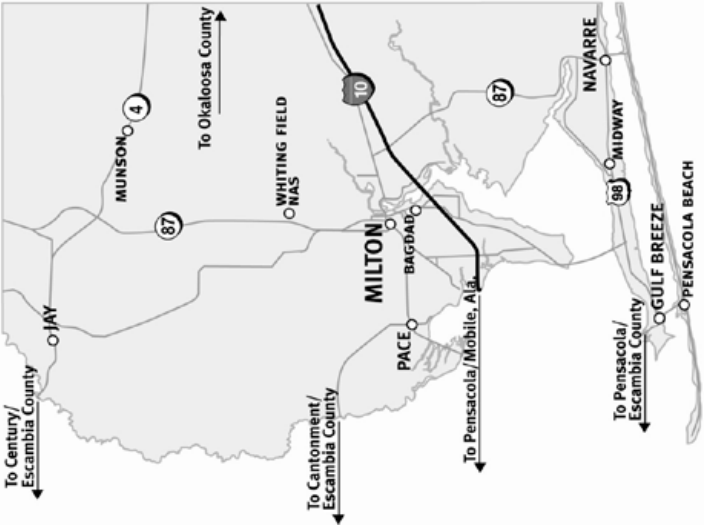

**HOW TO REQUEST FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE  
FROM THIS AGENCY LIST**

1. Check first to see if they serve your county
2. Check times to call—most are early morning
3. **CALL agencies, NO walkin service available.**
4. Continue to redial until you either speak to a staff member or you reach the Agency's answering machine

**Things to Remember**

1. Agencies will screen calls to verify eligibility
2. Most agencies serve only once per year or per lifetime
3. United Way 2-1-1 has up-to-date information on funding availability at agencies

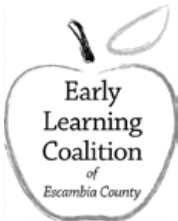
